**5 pillars of Islam** - 5 most important rules within Islam.

**Ancestors** - people from the past.

**Anglican** - an adjective for anything relating to the Anglican Church; e.g. The Church in Wales / Church of England.

**Anglo-Catholic** - an adjective for anything relating to both the Anglican and Catholic traditions.

**Awen** - the creative force that flows through nature.

**Barclodiad y Gawres** - a neolithic burial chamber in Anglesey.
